HALL OF FAME Recognizes a retired or deceased IAFCS/AAFCS member having a membership of 25 years or more for their lifelong contributions to the Family and Consumer Sciences profession and association.

RESEARCH AWARD Recognizes an IAFCS/AAFCS member for five consecutive years prior to nomination for his/her contributions to the information base of Family and Consumer Sciences.

NEW ACHIEVER AWARD Recognizes an IAFCS/AAFCS member having a membership at least five consecutive years and within 15 years of receiving his/her first Family and Consumer Sciences degree to identify and honor emerging FCS professionals with potential for achieving significant accomplishments in and through Family and Consumer Sciences.

TEACHER OF THE YEAR AWARD Recognizes an IAFCS/AAFCS member having a membership for five consecutive years prior to nomination to a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher for his/her innovative and creative programming and teaching methods in the Family and Consumer Sciences field and for effectiveness in stimulating student motivation and personal growth.

STUDENT OF THE YEAR Recognizes an outstanding secondary student with a strong interest in pursuing a Family and Consumer Sciences related career.

UNIVERSITY STUDENT OF THE YEAR Recognizes an university student who displays outstanding qualities of leadership in a FCS university program.

PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD Recognize a non-Family and Consumer Sciences professional who has provided significant contributions towards furthering the IAFCS program and improving family life in Iowa.
